

INCREASED LEARNING LEVELS: CASE STUDY

English Learner students in Santa Ana, California participated in the WRiTE BRAiN authoring program during their 10-week summer session aimed at preventing summer learning loss. Administrative Staff reported that the level of **student engagement** and **attendance** for summer programming was at its highest during the WRiTE BRAiN implementation.

Of the **2,561 students**, who had both a pre- and post-writing assessment score:

- 96% experienced NO LEARNING LOSS
- 45% experienced a LEARNING GAIN

Of the **1,145 students** who experienced a learning gain: (rubric is 1 to 4 measurement)




